Congleton town centre improvements

Dear sir / madam,

Plans to change Congleton town centre have been finalised following extensive consultation with the local community. The scheme has started, and will deliver junction improvements and an enhanced town centre environment over the coming months.

Progress report

Excavation of existing footway & planters from 'WH Smith' through to 'Chatwins' on the north side of Bridge Street.

Installation of new electrical ducts and slot drain.

Installation and grouting of new granite block paving from 'WH Smith' through to 'Chatwins' on the north side of Bridge Street.

Installation of new cycle racks.
