Plans to change Congleton town centre have been finalised following extensive consultation with the local community. The scheme has started, and will deliver junction improvements and an enhanced town centre environment over the coming months.

Progress report

Full installation of the north footway between Victoria Street and Crema Deli.
Grouting of this footway.
Excavation of the existing carriageway and footway paving at Victoria Street.
Installation of the concrete foundation at this location for the new granite paving.
Commenced the installation of the granite paving 'fan' pattern.
