2021 Statistics - in the UK ...

- + 99.3% of women have been subjected to sexual harassment or sexual violence at some point
- + 94% of girls under 18 have been catcalled in the street
- 35% of girls in school uniform have been sexually harassed in
- + 51% of women say they have woken to find their partner having sex with them
- + 95% of serious domestic violence has a male perpetrator and femal e victim
- 93% of murderers are men
- 94% of women do not believe the criminal justice does a good job in holding perpetrators of VAWG to account.
- They are right: rape conviction rates are so low the government has recently apologised and promised to try to improve. Rape is effectively decriminalised, as more than 98% of alleged perpetrators walk free.
- More than 98% of rapists are male (even when the victim is male)

- In Congleton: 98% of victims of domesti se reported to mvCW are women.
- We have one incident of mestic abuse reported t the Police every day on



9 out of 10 of those coming to our White Ribbon group saying they have been tims of male violence of




White Ribbon Conference

- All videos are now available on CTC's YouTube as a <u>Playlist</u>









We tied White Ribbons on lampposts and the Town Hall gates, flew the White Ribbon flag and put posters and leaflets in the information centre.









