

Project update

Congleton town centre improvements

Dear sir / madam,

Plans to change Congleton town centre have been finalised following extensive consultation with the local community. The scheme has started, and will deliver junction improvements and an enhanced town centre environment over the coming months.

Progress report

New wall at south west corner (RBS Bank) completed except for coping stones.
Carriageway at top of Bridge Street excavated.
Works for the upgraded controlled crossing at Market Street completed.
Laying of granite paving at north west corner footway (B&M).
Commenced installing kerb-lines at the top end of Bridge Street.

Photo Number 1 shows the new granite kerbline and paving at the north west footway (B & M).



Photo Number 2 shows the new wall construction adjacent to the new staircase at the south east footway (Barclays Bank).



Photo number 3 shows the construction of the new wall at the south west footway (RBS Bank).



Photo number 4 shows the further construction of the new granite kerbline at the north west footway down to Bridge Street (B&M).

Looking ahead

Complete the installation of new kerblines and granite paving in the carriageway at the top end of Bridge Street.

Installation of the coping stones on the new wall on the south west corner (RBS Bank).

Installation of the new handrail on the staircase at the south west corner (RBS Bank).

Installation of the railing on top of the new wall.

Installation of the street furniture (litter bins & planters).

No road closure at Market Street will be in operation this coming Sunday – 12 November, to ensure that the Remembrance Day Parade is not affected or disrupted in any way.
