

Project update

Congleton town centre improvements

Dear sir / madam,

Plans to change Congleton town centre have been finalised following extensive consultation with the local community. The scheme has started, and will deliver junction improvements and an enhanced town centre environment over the coming months.

Progress report

Majority of new lighting columns are now in place.

Footway paving completed on both north and south footways from Swan Bank to Victoria Street.

Existing 'planter' at Victoria Street removed and reinstated with block paving.

New granite bench 'uplighting' is now connected.

Installation of the transition kerb detail on Victoria Street.

Photo number 3 shows the installation of one of the new lighting columns.



All works are currently on programme.

Looking ahead

Installation of the new wooden seating onto the granite bench.

Excavate the south footway between Costa Coffee and Card Factory.

Pouring of the concrete between these locations.

Laying the new granite paving between these locations.
