Congleton town centre improvements

Dear sir / madam,

Plans to change Congleton town centre have been finalised following extensive consultation with the local community. The scheme has started, and will deliver junction improvements and an enhanced town centre environment over the coming months.

Progress report

Continuation of laying new granite paving for the footways.
Install the shuttering for the concrete for the granite bench.
Installation of the two linear slot drains.
Continuation of laying new granite paving for Swan Bank carriageway.
Install new granite kerbs at the top of Swan Bank
Resurfacing the carriageway approaches to the granite paving at Swan Bank

Swan Bank was be reopened to traffic on Monday 11 September, as programmed.

Photo Number 1 shows the new footway granite paving at Swan Bank.




Photo Number 2 shows the installation of the shuttering for the concrete foundation for the granite bench.
