Congleton town centre improvements

Plans to change Congleton town centre have been finalised following extensive consultation with the local community. The scheme has started, and will deliver junction improvements and an enhanced town centre environment over the coming months.

Progress report

Planing of the existing carriageway surfacing at Swan Bank. Excavation of the bindercourse & sub-base layers (bottom layers of the carriageway). Removal of the setts from within these lower layers of carriageway.

Further work was also carried out on Sunday 06 August 2017 to maximise works progress under the road closure.
