Congleton town centre improvements

Dear sir / madam,

Plans to change Congleton town centre have been finalised following extensive consultation with the local community. The scheme has started, and will deliver junction improvements and an enhanced town centre environment over the coming months.

Progress report

Completion of the fan pattern granite paving at Victoria Street.

Grouting of the transition detail at Little Street.

Grouting of the transition details at High Street, Market Street & Moody Street.

Replacement of the existing kerbs and tarmac reinstatement with new granite key kerbs on the north footway of Bridge Street (adjacent to the Crema Deli and Chatwins)

Installation of granite paving up to the new key kerbs at this location.


<u>Photo number 1 shows the excavation for the new key kerbs at Bridge Street (adjacent to the crema Deli).</u>

All works are currently on programme.

Looking ahead

Continue to replace the existing kerbs and tarmac reinstatement at Bridge Street (adjacent to Crema Deli), with new granite key kerbs.

Continue to install granite paving up to the key kerbs at this location.

Commence the excavation of the south footway on Bridge Street (adjacent to Costa Coffee and Boots Pharmacy).

Installation of the concrete foundation at this location.

Installation of new granite paving at this location.
