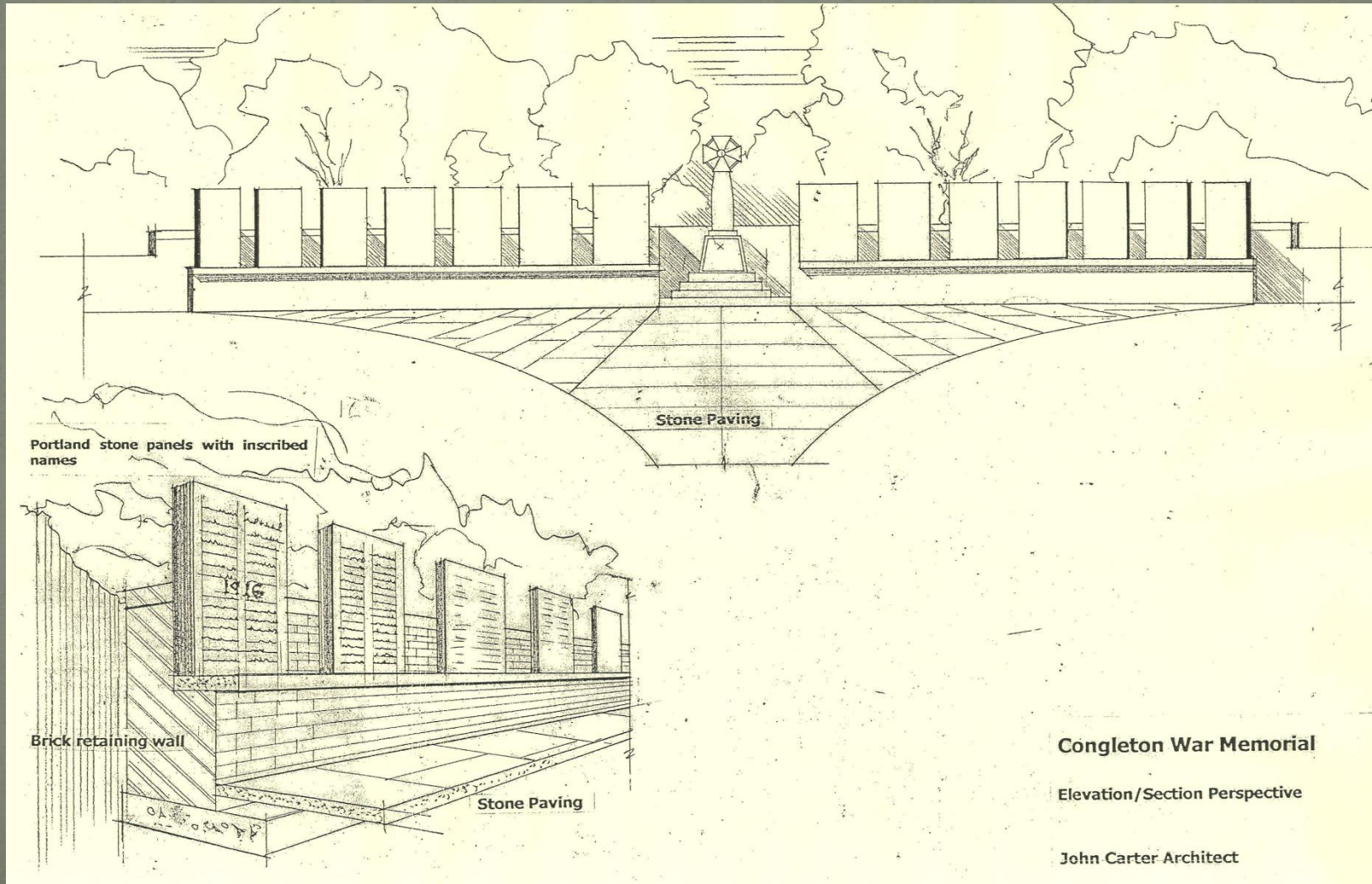

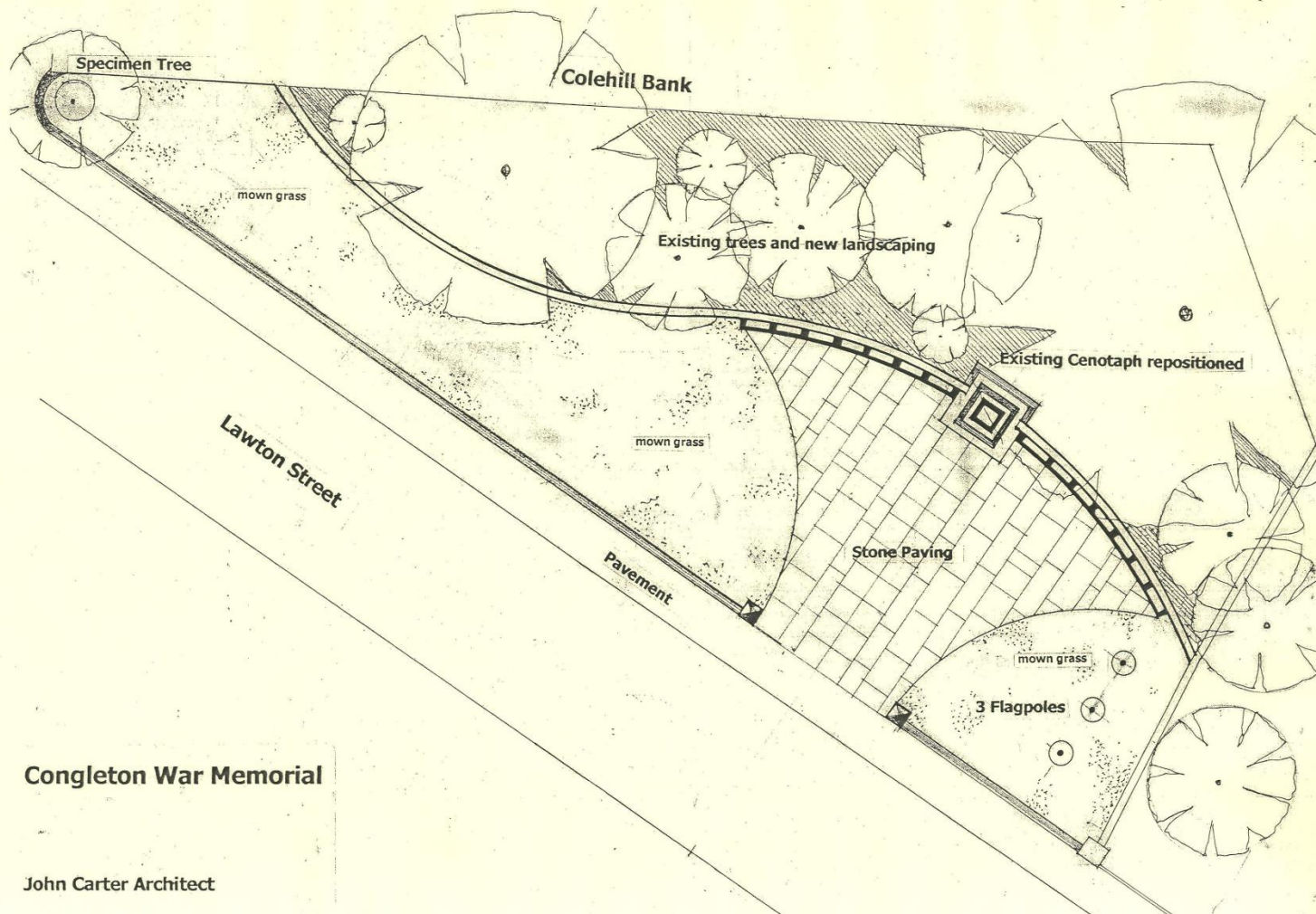

2018 – 19 Review

- Complete the Regulation 15 version of the plan and submit it to Cheshire East Council – **Completed**
- 6 week consultation – **Completed**
- Cheshire East review comments received and any points raised are taken on board **Completed**
- Cheshire East then appoint an Examiner – **Completed**
- Report considered by an Examiner (**current**)
- The Neighbourhood Plan is put before a local referendum



2018 – 19 Review

- 19th December 2018 Examiner's letter is received seeking clarification on many aspects including Housing and Green Open Spaces policies
- 20th February 2019 detailed responses sent to the Examiner on questions raised in his letter
- 22nd May 2019 Exploratory Meeting with the Examiner on way forward

Potential outcomes

- Go back through consultation process as there have been changes/ tightening up of policies from the original Consultation – Most likely date of referendum Spring 2020
- Go straight through to Referendum which would then make it likely to take place in November 2019

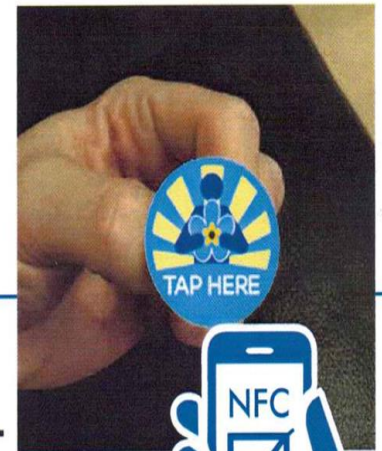
