

Keeping you up-to-date with our work on the Congleton Link Road project.

We are delighted with the progress that has been made across the entire Congleton Link Road scheme in recent months, despite the challenges in relation to COVID-19 and inclement weather conditions.

Summary of completed work:

- Completion of the new roundabout junction on Sandbach Road
- Completion of Giantswood Lane Bridge it offers a great viewing point of the new mainline currently under construction
- Approximately 2km of the 5.7km of new carriageway being constructed has been tarmacked and the largest section of mainline has had subbase laid
- Two new pedestrian underpasses have been installed on Manchester Road
- Completion of the waterproofing works to the River Dane structure
- The riverbank erosion protection works on both sides of the River Dane accomplished

Key ongoing work:

- Following delivery and installation of the 14
 pre-cast concrete bridge beams to Loach Brook
 Bridge, work to the bridge deck is now
 complete, with final concrete pours to the
 south side of the structure to be carried out
 this month.
- The Chelford road overbridge has been opened to traffic, with the realignment of the carriageway to both sides of the structure being undertaken ahead of the final surfacing works being carried out.
- Surfacing of the 87m River Dane bridge deck.
