

THE ALE TASTER

In 1272 Congleton was granted the right to appoint an Ale Taster. This was a serious and responsible role. The appointed officer had a duty to check on the goodness of the town's beers and bread, to make sure that they were wholesome and good for the townsfolk! The Ale Taster was able to fine or punish those who produced poor or unhealthy produce, or cheated

on the ingredients.



In April 2022,

Benedict Goodale,

aka Paul Boswell, was appointed as Congleton's Ale Taster. This is a ceremonial role, with no

WHAT IS REAL ALE?

Cask-conditioned beer is brewed and served the traditional way using natural ingredients (mainly malted barley, hops, water and yeast). The brew is allowed to condition and is left un-pasteurised and un-pressurised - no extra nitrogen or carbon dioxide is added, meaning that it can mature naturally - the yeast remains alive, conditioning the beer down to the last pint.
