<b>Updates</b>	<p><b>CE/15/2223 - Food and Friendship in the Town Hall</b></p> <p>These events have now started, with the first one held on Monday 16 October 2022. Mark Bailey from Mark's Events has also held a training session for 10 volunteers who have offered to help at the sessions and has approached local businesses about supporting the initiatives. The Food and Friendship clubs are being held on a Monday lunchtime and Thursday teatime co-ordinated by Mark's Events.</p> <p><b>CE/28/2223 – Community Safety Charter Pledge</b></p> <p>Congleton Town Council has signed up to the Community Charter Pledge and sought a meeting with the Neighbourhood Watch Police Co-ordinator to help plan the next stages.</p> <p><b>CE/33/2223 – Support for Ukrainian Hosts</b></p> <p>Contact has been made with the Congleton Ukrainian Support Network to take forward the idea of a host session in the Town Hall.</p> <p><b>CE/34/2223 – Ukrainian Christmas Event in Congleton</b></p> <p>A meeting has been planned for the 2 November 2022 to discuss the event details with the Ukrainian organisers.
