## **Allotment/Community Garden Plan**

The current plans are for a phased mixed allotment/community garden model. Initially there will only be 10-15 plots, all of which would be given to local community organisations/groups rather than individuals – this could include schools, youth groups and community groups etc.


There will be communal secure sheds for tool storage and no structures over 1 metre will be permitted on any of the plots. There will be a communal compost area.

Subsequent plot allocations will be decided by a committee consisting of people using the initial plots, Town Council Officers, Volunteers, and members of local partniship who will be working with i.e Stocks at the Pavilion and Food and Friendship Group, we will include a set of criteria for prioritisation - including priority for those with no/limited access to gardens/growing spaces.

Furthermore there will be a community garden, where residents and visitors can sit and enjoy the surroundings as well as enjoy watching the different wildlife visiting the site, there will be a mix of wildflower meadows,

We would love feedback on our plans with suggestions for how to improve the plans.
