Environmental Considerations	Whilst the ultimate goal in waste management is to reduce the amount of waste created, the second tier of any waste strategy is effective reuse and recycling. Having a state of the art waste disposal and/or waste recycling facility in Congleton would be the most environmentally friendly solution. This would keep mileage to and from a site to a minimum, incentivise residents to keep recycling and reduce fly tipping to pre-closure levels.
Equality Considerations	The lack of a local waste and recycling centre disadvantages a number of sectors of the community and this is why it is important to continue to make efforts to make access to waste and recycling services practical for those without their own transport, with limited mobility and limited time due to their work or domestic circumstances.
