

TITLE	Speed Indication Device			
Summary	The Town Council has received several requests from people wanting Speed Indication Devices (SIDs) fitted on their roads. Although Road Safety is a Cheshire East function, and speeding is a criminal offence dealt with by the Police, the requests find their way to Town and Parish Councils.  The Town Council does not currently own any working Speed Indication			
	Devices and those in existence in Congleton are owned by CEC (Park Lane, Padgbury Road, Biddulph Road, Leek Road, Sandbach Road).			
	Speed Indication Devices are effective in warning drivers about their speed and usually result in drivers slowing down.			
	The cost of purchasing a solar-operated device is around £3.5k. Gaining a suitable site with a power source is not practicable, which means that a solar-operated device is best. CEC Highways will charge £115 for a licence for the SID, and £115 for a consultation if the SID is to be relocated. CTC would be responsible for attaching the device and for insuring the device and the post. – see chart on the reverse of this paper.
